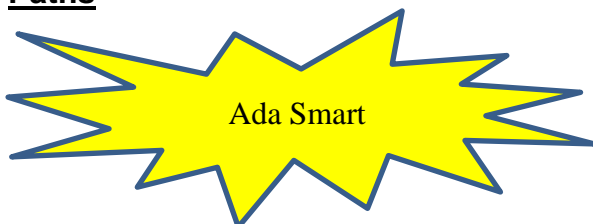
Foundation (prep) students are to stay home on Wednesdays throughout February to avoid them from becoming over tired.
