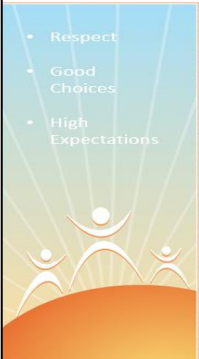

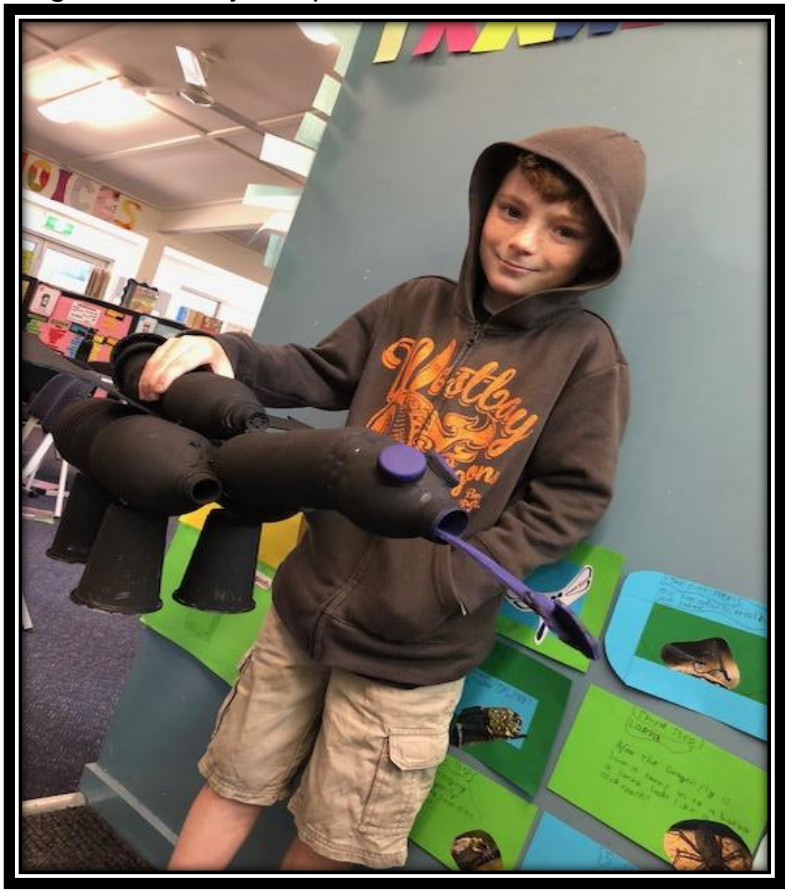

Road Closure

John Holland will be undertaking some pavement repairs on the Western Highway between Carpenter Road and Smiths Lane.

At some stage they need to repair asphalt at the Trawalla intersection which will affect the left turn into Trawalla for motorists travelling eastbound.

During these repairs eastbound motorists travelling to Trawalla will need to travel to Ercildoune Rd / Pin Oak Court Intersection and perform a u-turn and enter Trawalla via the exit ramp at Mt Emu Creek, please refer to marked up map attached.

They are still in the process of refining their repair program and at this stage they don't have an exact date for us as to when this change will take place however they will provide at least 2 weeks' notice prior to implementing any changes.
