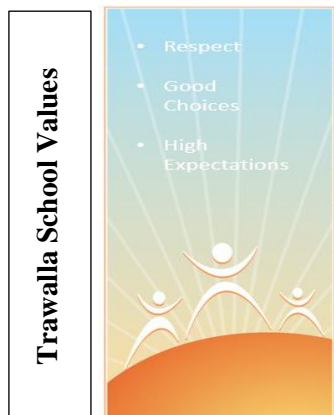
Principal update
