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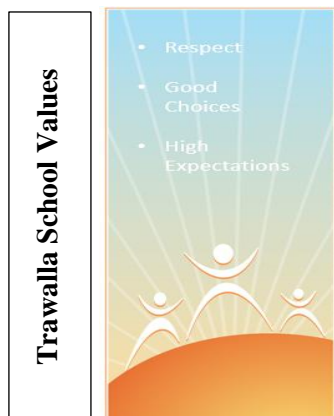

GUIDELINES:

1. The Lego theme is “At the Show”.
2. The Lego is to be built on a no larger than 30cm square board with the model being at least 95% Lego.
3. Place cards and boxes of Lego will be awarded for first, second and third in each class.
4. The age groups are :-
 - 1. Grade 2 and under.
 - 2. Grade 3 – 4
 - 3. Grade 5 – Year 8.
5. Send in your best two photographs from different angles to give the judge the best view of your work. Please email the photos to the secretary Fleur Hillman fh1973@hotmail.com by Friday 14th August.
6. Details will also be on the Beaufort Show website.
7. After the judging the photos will be uploaded to the Beaufort Show Facebook page and the website and will also be displayed in a Beaufort Shop window.
