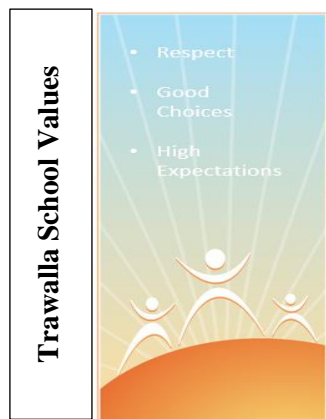

Full STEAM Ahead

Yesterday we travelled to Landsborough for the first Full STEAM Ahead day for 2019. It was great to catch up with everyone again. Natte Yallock has a new principal, Mr Kane Tolliday and Amphitheatre's new principal is Mr Matthew Beechey. Navarre is back running as a school with 6 students.

In music, we learnt how rhythms can be made by clapping and by using drumsticks. The art class started creating hand inspired artworks to display how an individual is connected to their community. An added extra to the FSA days this year is that the 3-6 students will be participating in organised sport/games at lunch times. Yesterday the older students got to play 'Capture the Flag', a game that sees two teams competing to infiltrate the opposition's territory and steal their flag.

CSEF – Camps, Sports & Excursions fund

If you applied for the CSEF at your child's school in a previous year, you do not need to complete an application form in 2019 unless there has been a change in your family circumstances. Your child's school will apply for the CSEF on your behalf.

You will only need to submit an application form in 2019 if any of the following changes have occurred:

- **new student enrolments:** your child has started or changed schools in 2019 or you did not apply at the same school in a previous year
- **changed family circumstances:** such as a change of custody, change of name, concession card number, or new siblings commencing at the school in 2019.

Schools are able to accept and process applications up until the end of term two each year.

CSEF payments are made to schools from March onwards each year.
