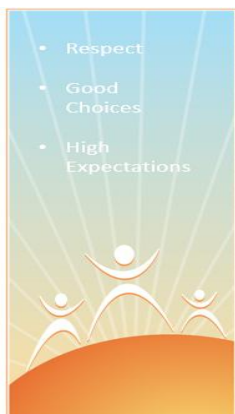

Student Code of Conduct

Attached to today's newsletter is a copy of the Trawalla Code of Conduct which outlines the rights and responsibilities of students, staff and parents. The playground and classroom rules are clearly outlined along with the consequences for breaches of the Code of Conduct. Students will be issued with a discipline notice ("a pink slip") if a student's behaviour is deemed to be severe as outlined in the severe clause/suspension part of the Code of Conduct. In the event of a pink slip being sent home, parents are to discuss the behaviour with the child and return the signed "pink slip" to school the next day.

Parents are asked to read and discuss the Code of Conduct document with their children. Attached to this newsletter is an agreement white slip for each student that has a place for parents and students to sign to state that all parties agree to conditions of the Code of Conduct. Please return the signed agreement to school.

Before and After School Care Opportunity

Trawalla and Beaufort district families are in need of child care services and we may be able to help...

We believe that the families in the Beaufort and district community are disadvantaged due to not being able to get access to Before and After School care for school aged children. Trawalla Primary School has space to run such a service but we need to gauge community interest.

A service run at Trawalla Primary School would still enable students to attend Beaufort Primary School as we could utilise the current bus services in our area. That means that students that use the Before and After School care could attend either Beaufort PS or Trawalla PS depending on where they live. Our school explored this idea in 2019 and we were unable to find suitable staff for the sessions. We would like to gather data on interest and if anyone is interested in being a carer.

School Fees

All students have been issued with stationery, books and computer subscriptions for 2021. The cost to families is \$80 per child. Families are asked to pay these costs by March 19th.

COVID safe School reminders:

- Students to arrive after 8.55am.
- Visitors are to limit their time on the school grounds and use sanitiser in front corridor.
- Ensure physical distancing (1.5m)
- Bus travel is unaffected.
- Unwell students are to stay home. Students will be sent home if they become unwell at school.

Practise good hygiene

- Use non-contact greetings (not shaking hands, hugging or kissing).
- Ensure the highest hygiene practices amongst food handlers where these services are operating, as per the Department's Safe Food Handling Guidance.

East Grampians Health Services Mobile Dental Service is coming to the Cluster Day at Moonambel on March 15th. This provides free dental check ups and follow up work for all students. Completed consent forms are to be returned to school by Friday March 5th.

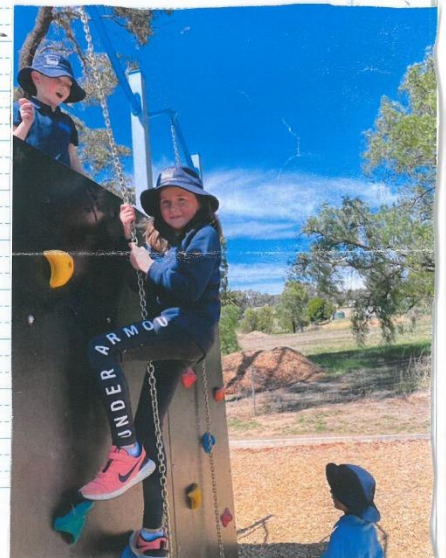
