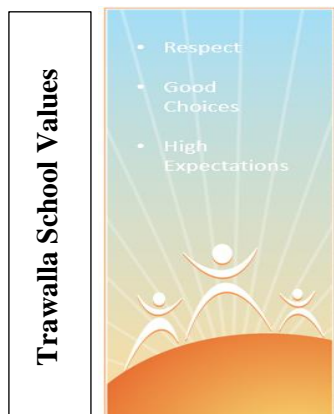

### Trawalla Code of Conduct

Last week I sent home the Trawalla Code of Conduct, parents/guardians were asked to read and discuss the document with their children. Thanks to those families that have returned the signed agreement to school. All signed agreements are to be sent to school as a record of each families' commitment to our school and the safety of everyone.

### **IMPORTANT** CSEF – Camps, Sports & Excursions fund

If you applied for the CSEF at your child's school in a previous year, you do not need to complete an application form in 2020 unless there has been a change in your family circumstances. Your child's school will apply for the CSEF on your behalf.

You will only need to submit an application form in 2020 if any of the following changes have occurred:

- **new student enrolments:** your child has started or changed schools in 2020 or you did not apply at the same school in a previous year
- **changed family circumstances:** such as a change of custody, change of name, concession card number, or new siblings commencing at the school in 2020.

Schools are able to accept and process applications up until the end of term two each year. CSEF payments are made to schools from March onwards each year.

### Curriculum Day

All staff will be attending a Professional Learning day at Bungaree on Tuesday March 10<sup>th</sup> 2020. This will be a pupil free day.

### Llanberris Athletics

The Trawalla school students compete in athletics against Waubra and Mount Blowhard schools on Friday, March 27<sup>th</sup> 2020. The event is held at Llanberris Athletics Centre in Ballarat. All students are to be taken to the venue by their parents and can be taken home at the conclusion of their events. Prep students finish at lunchtime, older students will be finished by 2.30pm. Students are asked to bring their hats, warm clothes and drinks as the weather could be warm or very cold. The canteen will be open and there will also be a coffee van at the sports. (TBC) Students need to be at the venue by 9am for a 9.15 start.
