Our next Full STEAM Ahead day is Monday, April 1st.

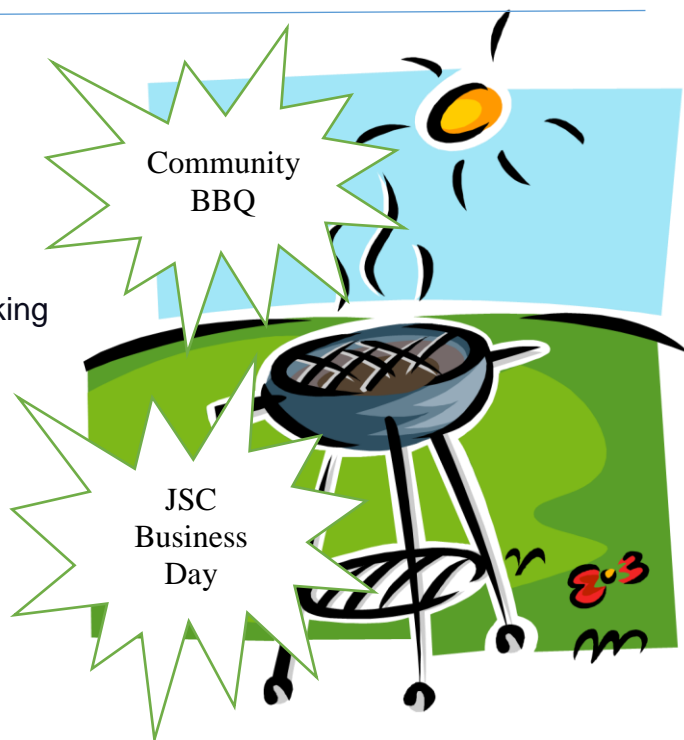
