Each home learning pack has an activity book for each student. This is a little something from us to you to bring a smile to the face of the learner. Enjoy!

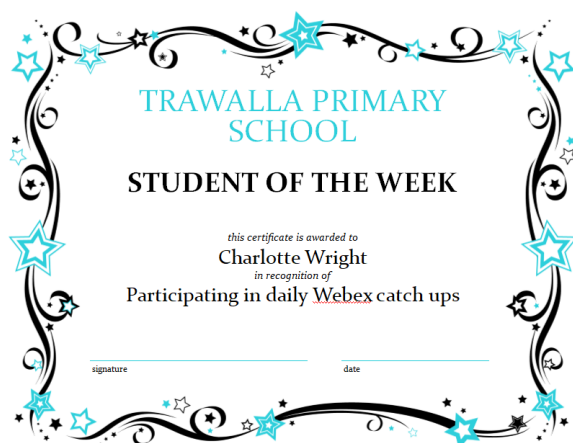
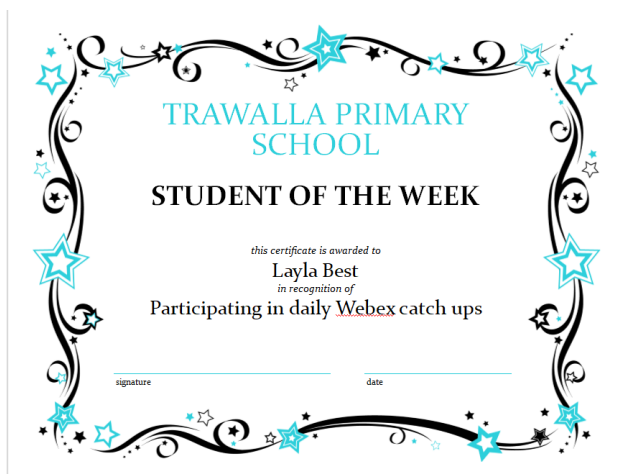
Attendance
